

Dear Player:

I would like to take this opportunity as Zone 6 Co-ordinator for Football for the Alberta Summer Games to extend an invitation for you and your parents to attend an information and registration meeting to be held on Monday, May 10, 2010 regarding try-outs for the football team representing Edmonton for the 2010 Alberta Summer Games. The registration and meeting will be held at 7 p.m. at the offices of the Chargers Football Club (6025 - 86 Street, second floor above Scotiabank). **Attendance at this meeting and registration is mandatory.**

The Alberta Summer Games will be held in Peace River from July 22 through July 25, 2010. There are eight zones in the Province of Alberta, each of which is eligible to send a football team to the Games. Each team will consist of 35 players who will be graduating in June from Grade 9 or lower Grades and will not turn 17 during the calendar year of 2010. Anyone, regardless of gender or previous playing experience, fitting the age category may try out for the team.

There will be a selection camp for interested players on the following dates:

The selection camp will be using the football fields at W.P. Wagner High School located at 86 Street and Wagner Road (60 Avenue). The dressing rooms will be at the Chargers Football Club across the street from the field at 6025 - 86 Street.

The cost of this selection camp is \$ 75 per player. Fees must be paid in cash or certified cheque payable at the meeting to the "Edmonton All Stars Bantam Football Team".

A registration form is enclosed, please read it carefully before completing and signing it. This form along with a photocopy of your birth certificate, Alberta Health Care card and your latest report card (we only need to see the area noting the school and grade you are in) must be submitted at the registration meeting on May 10. It would be preferable if you could bring photocopies of these documents with you.

Players should contact the bantam team they played with in 2009 with regard to usage of equipment for the camp.
